Solution-Oriented Advocacy



Advocating for the needs and interests of Canada's aerospace industry is a **primary focus** for our AIAC team.

We are actively engaged in discussions and consultations on the policy issues that impact the growth, competitiveness and sustainability of companies working in defence, civil aviation, space and related sectors across the supply chain.



- **Industrial Aerospace Strategy**

Advocate for comprehensive, long-term strategies for aerospace and for defence that strengthen Canada's industrial base, competitiveness, innovation and global leadership.

- **Defence Industrial Strategy (DIS), Defence Investment Agency (DIA) & Industrial and Technological Benefits (ITB) Policy**

Advocate for a comprehensive Defence Industrial Strategy with clear implementation and operational guidance through the Defence Investment Agency (DIA), a modernized and more efficient Industrial and Technological Benefits (ITB) Policy, prioritization of key industrial capabilities, promotion of innovation, support for exports and enhancement of Canada's defence readiness.

- **Transport Canada's Certification Capacity**

Advocate for the resourcing and expertise needed to accelerate aeronautical certification, enabling rapid adoption of emerging technologies and maintaining Canada's reputation for aviation excellence.

- **Domestic Taxation Policy**

Protect Canadian aerospace jobs and supply chains by calling for the exemption of aircraft from the Select Luxury Items Tax.

- **Labour Market & Workforce Development**

Advocate for the expansion of skilled labour programs, streamlined immigration processes and youth engagement to address skilled talent shortages.

- **Export Permits and Controls**

Advocate for the simplification and harmonization of export processes with allied countries to improve market access and maintain global competitiveness.

- **Sustainable Aviation and Environmental Policy Development**

Support the implementation of a government-industry plan to scale SAF production and achieve Canada's aviation decarbonization targets and provide industry leadership on environmental issues like PFAS and chemicals.

- **Innovation Funding**

Advocate to maintain and enhance the Scientific Research and Experimental Development (SR&ED) program to ensure companies are rewarded for conducting R&D in Canada and ensure that the newly announced Strategic Response Fund meets industry needs.
