



Andrew Bevan is CEO of Catalyze4. Prior to being the Liberal National Campaign Co-Director in the 2025 election campaign, he was Chief of Staff to the Minister of Finance and Deputy Prime Minister, and Senior Advisor to the Prime Minister of Canada.

Before returning to government in 2023, he was in the private sector for five years as Executive Vice President of the Fakih Group, VP of Canadian Pathway Inc., and Executive Advisor to Mohamad Fakih, Founder of Paramount Fine Foods.

His career in public service began in 1993 with federal Member of Parliament John Godfrey. In 2004, Andrew was named Chief of Staff to Canada's Minister of State for Infrastructure and Communities.

In 2007, Andrew went on to serve as Chief of Staff and, subsequently, Principal Secretary to the Leader of the Official Opposition in Ottawa, for two years before becoming the Executive Director of Sustainable Prosperity, the green economy think tank based at the University of Ottawa in 2009.

Between 2011 and 2013 Andrew was Executive Director of the Canadian Boreal Forest Agreement Secretariat. Andrew served as Premier Kathleen Wynne's Principal Secretary from when she took office in February 2013, and assumed the additional responsibilities of Chief of Staff in January 2016 until June 2018.
